INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine
- Service of the crew (skipper, hostess/cook)
- Half board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Trogir, Croatia: breakfast, lunch or dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),
Towels: 1 set of towels / pax / charter (1 set = 1 face towel / 1 bath towel / 1 beach towel)
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)
- Water sports on board: snorkeling gear & 1 paddleboard
- End cleaning
- Harbour and mooring fees
- On catamarans 54 ft and larger: shower gel & shampoo plus a 2nd paddleboard

The rates do not include:

- Cruising and tourist taxes, clearance and custom fees, island fees if there are any
- Cancellation insurance and private insurance
- Alcoholic drinks (possible to order separately) and special meal requests
- Personal expenses and excursions
- Crew gratuity
- And more generally that is not explicitly stated

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Split Airport (SPU): The airport is 9km from the base, which is a 15-minute journey by car.

There are regular flights from all major European airports with all major airline carriers. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings. Or call directly at 00 385 99 424 8844.

ACCESS BY ROAD

From the airport take the street Ulica Dr. Franje Tuđmana to Trogir. When you pass Trogir continue to Seget by street Ulica Hrvatskih žrtava. When you arrive to Seget, the marina is on the left side.

ACCESS BY BUS

Take local bus number 37 to city Trogir (15 minutes). From Trogir to the marina in Seget it takes 15 minutes by foot.

AREA GUIDE

SAILING AREA

There may be no better way to explore Trogir's castles, churches, palaces, towers and the rich history on Croatia's Adriatic coast than aboard a yacht. In fact, a Trogir sailing vacation starts and ends a short walk from the rich, living history of this UNESCO World Heritage site.

From our base in Marina Baotić, Trogir you'll be right in the heart of a wide variety of islands, old towns, and protected parks.

TOP THINGS TO DO IN TROGIR:

1. Sail to Šolta Island in time for sunset: It's the perfect spot to venture out and explore many of the central Dalmatian Islands during your Trogir sailing charter.

2. Swim, Snorkel, dive, and fish off the island of Brac: There are lots of things to do in Brac, as it's one of the larger islands. It has 11 towns and villages and is home to the resorts of Supetar and Bol, both famous for fabulous beaches.
3. Visit the Pakleni Islands: The islands in this small sub-group of the central Dalmatians are known for magnificent beaches, and their old world charm.
4. Go shopping (and dancing) in the picturesque village of Komiza: Komiza is known for its pleasant shops, restaurants, and popular nightclub a short distance from the village center on Kamencia Beach.
5. Walk Trogir's Old City: If you're on a Trogir sailing charter, make sure to take time to walk through the walled city and visit its numerous gothic cathedrals.

WEATHER

The best seasons to enjoy a cruise in Trogir are undoubtedly late spring, summer and early autumn, when the climate is sunny, warm and dry. July and August are the hottest months and the busiest.

The average temperature in Trogir in summer is between 78°F (26°C) and 95°F (32°C). And in February, the coldest month, it can be as low as 37°F (3°C).

The sea temperature in Trogir in summer is between 75°F (21°C) and 82°F (27°C).

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Trogir, Croatia:

- Summer high: The August high is around 87°F (30°C)
- Winter low: The January/February low is 39°F (3°C)

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
