HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Corfu International Airport (CFU): The airport is 8km from the base, which is a 20-minute journey by car/shuttle. There are regular flights from Athens with Olympic Airlines and Aegean Airlines. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

Taxis are available at the airport. They charge 25€. Transfer can be arranged by the base for taxis, mini buses or buses.

ACCESS BY BUS

There is a bus that leaves from the airport to downtown and, from there, bus number 7 stops outside of the marina. Walking distance from the bus stop to the base is 1km.

AREA GUIDE

LOCAL AREA INTRODUCTION

A yacht vacation in Corfu gives you access to the gateway to the Ionian Islands on the western side of mainland Greece. See the main island and smaller islands, and enjoy fertile landscapes with plentiful olive groves, clear blue waters for snorkeling and a mixture of different civilizations and cultures that harmoniously meld together.

Our base of Corfu is located at Gouvia Marina. Corfu is the northernmost and most popular Ionian island due to its stunning beaches and natural settings, a distinctive history, intriguing architectural and archaeological remains.

Start your Corfu sailing vacation exploring the compact, walkable old town, a cultural UNESCO World Heritage Site built between two Venetian fortresses. There is plenty to do here including touring the forts and the Archaeological Museum, in addition to the extensive selection of shops and restaurants.

WEATHER

The best seasons to enjoy a cruise in Corfu are undoubtedly late spring, summer and early autumn, when the weather is hot, sunny and dry. July and August are the hottest months in Corfu with an average high of 88°F (32°C) and a sea temperature of 75-77°F (23°C-25°C) The end of May, June and September are also very pleasant months in which to discover the region as there are fewer crowds and yet the weather is warm.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Corfu:

- Summer High: The July high is around 88°F (32°C)
- Winter Low: The January low is 50°F (10°C)

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewelry, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
