

NEW POLICY FOR DYW & NY - BAREBOAT CHARTERS WITH SKIPPER AND/OR COOK

Due to legal requirements in French territories and similar requests in other destinations like BVI or Greece, we will apply this new worldwide policy on our bareboat charters with crew (applies to Bareboat+skipper/cook & Easy Crewed):

“From 2026 in charter start date, crew on board must have their own toilets/ showers, with clear implications on attribution of cabin on catamarans where most toilets are only accessible through double cabin, especially on smaller models.”

This way, we set a high worldwide standard, offering better conditions for the skippers & cooks working for Dream Yacht Worldwide & Navigare Yachting. This in return will contribute to offer a high quality service to our guests on skippered & easy crewed charters.

I'll summarize below what it means for our charters with skipper and/or cook.

Obviously in case a double cabin is required for the crew, our bases will ensure that our guests get the most favourable double cabin in case not similar.

1 - Charter on monohulls.

Bookings with crew on boats with only 1 head are not allowed anymore.

For other monohulls, if there is a forepeak on board it can be used by skipper or cook, as long 1 of the heads is reserved for the crew.

2 - Charters on catamarans with only skipper or cook

Main policy on catamarans with 2 forepeak bed is to have 1 double cabin for skipper or cook

3 - Charters on catamarans with skipper & cook

Main policy on catamarans with 2 forepeak bed is to have 1 double cabin + 1 forepeak for skipper and cook

4 - Exceptions for more guest cabin

Catamarans with 1 forepeak bed + 1 forepeak toilet/shower OR Cats with a 5th bunk bed cabin OR Cats with forepeaks having bed, toilet & shower: exceptions are explained in the annex.

5 - Exception with less guest cabin

Catamarans without forepeak: see annex

ANNEX:
EXCEPTION TO MAIN POLICY DEPENDING ON LAYOUTS OF CATAMARANS

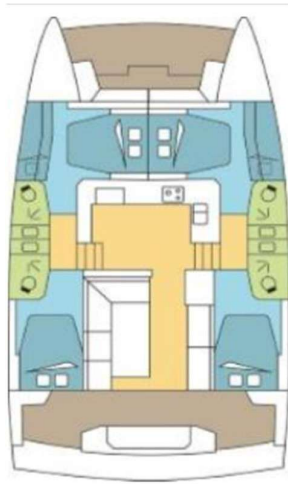
1 – CATAMARAN WITH NO FOREPEAK

Examples: Catspace or Bali 4.8 in 6 cab version

Also valid for catamarans where indicated in Nausys that forepeaks are only for children (like Bali 4.0).

A – Skipper or cook: 1 double cabin for the skipper or cook

B – Skipper and cook: 2 double cabin for the skipper and cook (**= less double cabin for guests!**)

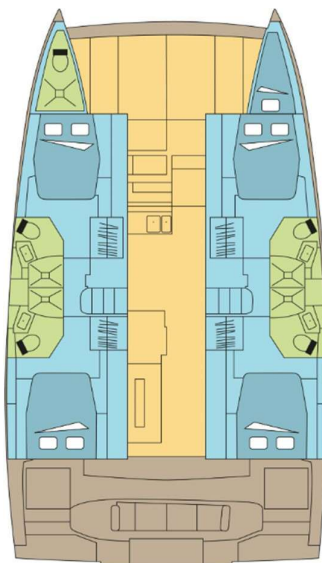


2 – CATAMARANS WITH 1 FOREPEAK BED +1 FOREPEAK TOILET/SHOWER

Possible from 42' and over depending on the shipyard. Detailed in Nausys specs & layout for our boats (example below is Bali 4.4 Mme Black in Dubrovnik).

A – Skipper or cook: 1 forepeak bed for the skipper or cook (**= more double cabin for guests!**)

B – Skipper and cook: 1 double cabin + 1 forepeak bed for the skipper and cook

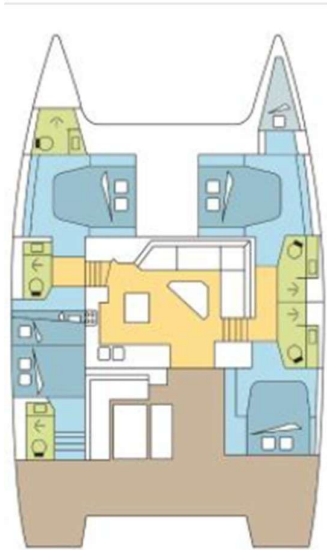


3 – CATAMARANS WITH A 5TH DOUBLE BUNK BED CABIN

Typical example: Tanna 47s or Bali 4.6

A – Skipper or cook: 1 bunk bed cabin for the skipper or cook (= **more double cabin for guests!**)

B – Skipper and cook: 1 bunk bed cabin + 1 forepeak bed for the skipper and cook (= **more double cabin for guests!**)



4 – CATAMARANS WITH 2 FOREPEAK WITH BED, TOILET & SHOWER

Typical example: Bali 5.4s in 6 cabin version

A – Skipper or cook: 1 forepeak for the skipper or cook (= **more double cabin for guests!**)

B – Skipper and cook: 2 forepeak for the skipper and cook (= **more double cabin for guests!**)
