INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine

- Half board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Athens: breakfast, lunch or dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Athens International Airport Eleftherios Venizelos (ATH): The airport is 30km from the base, which is a one-hour journey by car/shuttle. The airport services most of the known air carriers from many international destinations. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

ACCESS BY ROAD

Drive from Attiki Odos/A62, Leof. Koropiou Baris and Leof. Posidonos to Alimos.

ACCESS BY BUS

An express public bus (X96) departs every 20-30 minutes from the airport costing around €6 euro/per person. The bus stop is located at the marina entrance.

AREA GUIDE

SAILING AREA

Our base in Alimos, just south of Athens, is situated perfectly for sailing vacation in the serene Saronic Gulf. Sailing here is ideal for those seeking smooth, calm waters or a relaxed family vacation.

Athens offers diverse vacation and there is something for everyone. Experience impressive historical ancient ruins to open-air markets, secluded Greek islands to vibrant nightlife and delicious food.

You'll also enjoy warm hospitality and famous Greek cuisine on board your yacht.

It goes without saying that beaches, swimming and snorkeling in the crystal-clear blue-green waters are a must in Athens and the Saronic Gulf".

TOP THINGS TO DO IN ATHENS:

1. See the view from the Temple of Poseidon: Head to Sounion and walk among the giant gleaming white columns that date back to 444 BC and enjoy expansive views over the



distant Greek islands. As one of the top things to do in Athens, it can get busy, so a visit here is best first thing in the morning, or at sunset.

2. Lunch and sunbathing at Love Bay: This scenic little bay on Poros offers a day of relaxation with sun loungers, divine views and refreshments on tap. Stop for a snack and stay for a delightful swim.
3. Horseback riding in Hydra: With no cars permitted on the island, it's the perfect activity for touring the best of the island's scenery. There are a few different outfitters offering horseback riding.
4. Cafe hop in Poros: Spend a day in Poros, meander along the quaint streets, enjoy a few cafes while you people-watch and take in the stunning scenery in every direction.
5. Ancient Greek Theatre of Epidavros: One of our top things to do is spending some time touring this ancient amphitheater, famed for its classic Greek construction and astounding acoustics. This UNESCO-listed monument is even still used for concerts today, now that is a feat of sound engineering!

WEATHER

The best time to visit Athens and the Saronic Islands is summer with great temperatures averaging 86°F (30°C) in July and August and plenty of sunshine hours.

The Saronic Gulf and its islands have great weather conditions year-round with mild winters and dry summers. In spring, between March and May, and fall, between September and October, the weather is still sunny and warm with very little rain. The area has a long sailing season and conditions for Athens sailing vacations are normally relatively calm and popular with couples and families

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Athens:

- Summer High: The July high is around 91°F (33°C)
- Winter Low: The January low is 45°F (8°C)

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream



- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewellery, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
