### INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine
- Service of the crew (skipper, hostess/cook)
- Full board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Phuket: breakfast, lunch and dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),  
Towels: 1 set of towels / pax / charter (1 set = 1 face towel / 1 bath towel / 1 beach towel)
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)
- Water sports on board: snorkeling gear & 1 paddleboard
- End cleaning
- Harbour and mooring fees
- On catamarans 54 ft and larger: shower gel & shampoo plus a 2<sup>nd</sup> paddleboard

- Alcoholic drinks (possible to order separately) and special meal requests
- Personal expenses and excursions
- Crew gratuity

## HOW TO GET THERE?

---

### ACCESS BY PLANE

Phuket International Airport (HKT): The airport is 15km from the base, which is a 20-minute journey by car/shuttle. Fly via regular connecting flights from Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur, Singapore and others. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

### TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

### ACCESS BY ROAD

From the airport, follow Route 4031 and Route 402 to your destination.

It is essential that each passenger must have a passport valid for 6 months after the return date. A copy of your passports, of your flight details and any know food restrictions or medical diet must be sent at least 2 weeks before your departure to your cruise' organizer.

## SAILING CONDITIONS

---

### SAILING AREA

Thailand is among the finest, most interesting and beautiful places to sail in the world. Where else can you sail among spectacular limestone peaks that jut up above the waters, such as you can in Phang Nga Bay? The rock formations are just the start of the wonders you can find in Thailand. Many of the islands in this region are ringed with dazzling coral reefs so rich in marine life that you'll be tempted to spend all of your time in the water.

### TOP THINGS TO DO IN THAILAND:

1. Lunch at a floating fishing village: The hundreds of huts, restaurants and houses where the Koh Panyi villagers live are built on stilts over the surrounding sea. It's a fascinating place to visit, where you can enjoy a freshly-caught fish lunch, shop and visit with the friendly locals.
2. Visit James Bond Island: Excellent anchorages are to be found at the prestigious Phang Nga Bay, where you will also find the famed James Bond Island. Secret lagoons and crystal clear waters highlight the unspoiled beauty of this magical bay recognizable for the sheer limestone karsts that jut straight up from the water.
3. Hong Lagoon: Koh Hong, off the coast of Krabi is part of the Than Bok Khorani National Park and features one of the more recognizable lagoons in Thailand. Visit early to enjoy the stunning beach and walking trail before the tour visitors arrive.
4. Explore Koh Phi Phi Don: Koh Phi Phi Don is a popular tourist attraction and while it may not be the place to visit for solitude, it retains an appeal to visitors looking for a lively scene. Enjoy its beachfront restaurants, bars and shops at Tonsai Bay, blending in with the stunning scenery.

### WEATHER

The best time for a Thailand sailing charter is from mid-October to mid-April, when the rainy season is finished and all national parks are open. The monsoon season is May through early October, with hot, humid weather and heavy rains.

March is the hottest month in Phuket with an average temperature of 83°F (29°C) and the coldest is January at 81°F (27°C). The most sunshine hours are in April with nine hours of sun each day.

### TEMPERATURE

Climate in Phuket:

- Summer high: The March high is around 93°F (34°C)
- Winter low: The January low is 72°F (22°C)

### WHAT TO PACK

---

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors



- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- Leave expensive jewellery, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
