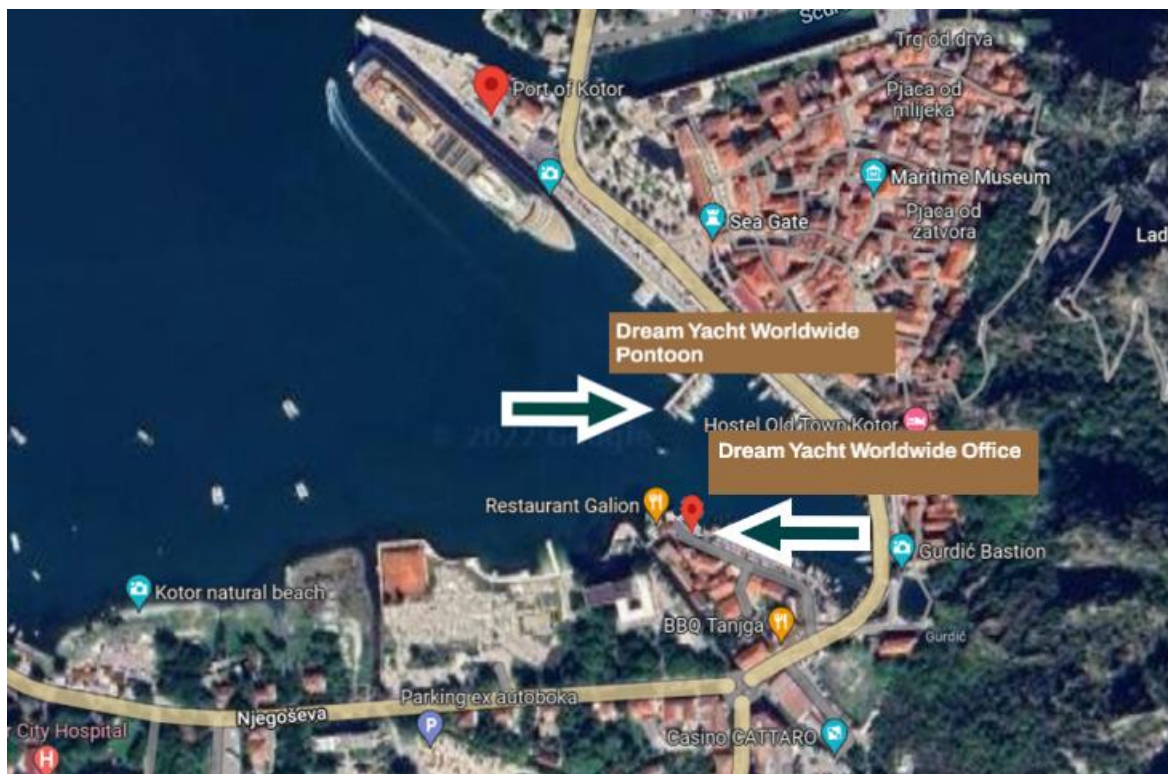

INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine
- Service of the crew (skipper, hostess/cook)
- Fullboard board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Montenegro: breakfast, lunch and dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),
Towels: 1 set of towels / pax / charter (1 set = 1 face towel / 1 bath towel / 1 beach towel)
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)
- Water sports on board: snorkeling gear & 1 paddleboard
- End cleaning
- Harbour and mooring fees
- On catamarans 54 ft and larger: shower gel & shampoo plus a 2nd paddleboard

The rates do not include:

- Cruising and tourist taxes, clearance and custom fees, island fees if there are any
- Cancellation insurance and private insurance
- Alcoholic drinks (possible to order separately) and special meal requests
- Personal expenses and excursions
- Crew gratuity
- And more generally that is not explicitly stated

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Tivat Airport (TIV): The airport is 9km from the base, which is a 15-minute journey by car/shuttle. Fly via Germany, UK or via Moscow. Please check the schedule on the [airport_website](#).

Dubrovnik Airport (DBV): The airport is 70km from the base, which is a 90-minute journey by car/shuttle. Fly direct from Philadelphia in peak times or via European cities. Please check the schedule on the airport website.

Podgorica Airport (TGD): The airport is 87km from the base, which is a 90-minute journey by car/shuttle. Fly via European cities. Please check the schedule on the airport website.

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

From Tivat Airport, take Jadranska Magistrala (Adriatic Motorway) in direction of Tivat Airport and Kotor. After passing the airport at roundabout take the 3rd exit and follow the direction to Kotor via Vrmac Tunnel. After exiting the tunnel, our offices are only 1km away in the direction of Kotor Old Town.

From Dubrovnik, take state road D8 and follow the direction to Dubrovnik Airport and Karasovići/Debeli Brijeg border crossing between Croatia and Montenegro. After entering Montenegro, follow E65 road in direction to Kotor and Budva. At Kamenari, there is a fast 24-hour ferry service to Lepetane which runs every 15 minutes and shortens the journey significantly (€4.5 toll). Alternatively continue on scenic road E65 in direction to Kotor for scenic views.

From Podgorica, there are two options for reaching Kotor. If you prefer scenic views take the M23 road and follow the direction to Budva as the road goes near Cetinje and Lovćen National Park. If you prefer a faster journey, take the E80 in the direction of Budva. From Budva, continue on E80 to Kotor.

ACCESS BY BUS

Kotor Bus station is located 200m from DYC Kotor base. There are frequent daily bus services to

Budva, Tivat and Podgorica with departures approximately every 30 minutes. There are also regular regional services to Dubrovnik, Split, Mostar, Belgrade and other destinations.

AREA GUIDE

SAILING AREA

Montenegro may be small, but its legendary history, impressive mountains, beautiful beaches and crystalclear water will be a big hit for your yacht charter vacation. The country boasts the UNESCO World Heritage sites of Perast and Kotor, an impressive Venetian fortress with a steep hike and fantastic view across the bay.

The peak times for a Montenegro boat rental are July and August. In summer the days are sunny and hot and the water temperatures are ideal for swimming.

TOP THINGS TO DO IN MONTENEGRO:

1. Visit the chapels on small islands near Perast: Sail to Perast for lunch and explore the chapels on the small islands of St. George and Our Lady of the Rocks nearby.
2. Explore Porto Montenegro: Take a walk around the new marina at Porto Montenegro that buzzes with excellent places to dine, shop and relax.
3. Check out the Blue Cave on your way to Herceg Novi: Enter and get treated to a unique light show where the water's reflections illuminate the cave roof.
4. Visit Budva: Budva, near the islet St. Stefan, is famous for its beautiful beaches and historic monuments, including mosaics dating to the 3rd century. If you love diving, stop by the two small islands of Katič and Sveta Neđelja nearby.
5. Visit the iconic Old City of Kotor: If you rent a boat in Kotor, make sure to take time to walk through the old city and visit the castle of San Giovanni. Climb up the steep fortifications on the hillside for the best view of the Bay of Kotor.

WEATHER

The best time to visit Montenegro is between May and October when the climate is sunny, hot and dry. The hottest and most crowded months to visit are June, July and August.

The average temperature in Montenegro in summer is 81°F (32°C). The sea temperature in Montenegro in summer is between 75°F (21°C) and 82°F (27°C), with August being the best month for swimming.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Kotor, Montenegro:

- Summer high: The August high is around 88°F (32°C)
- Winter low: The January low is 36°F (4°C)

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewellery, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
