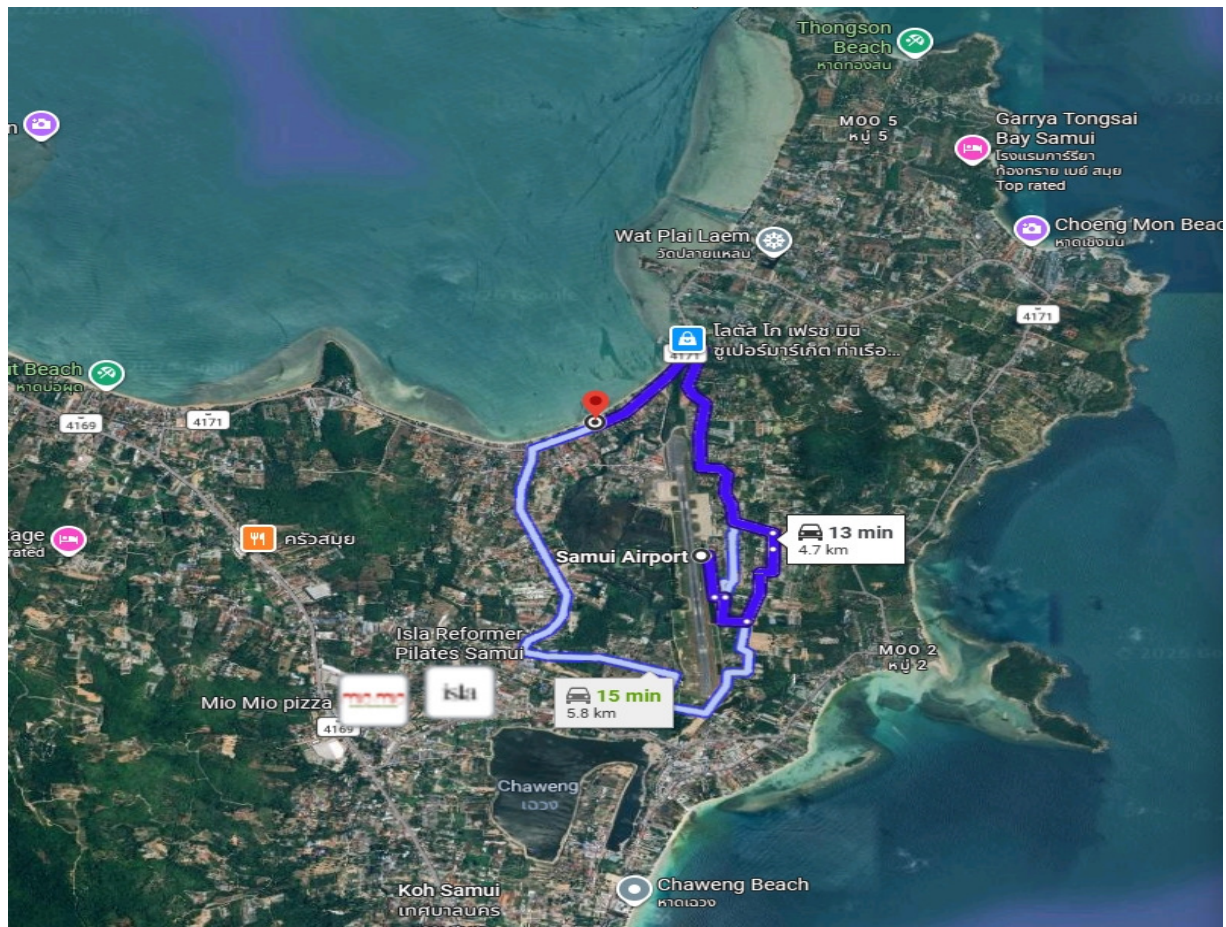

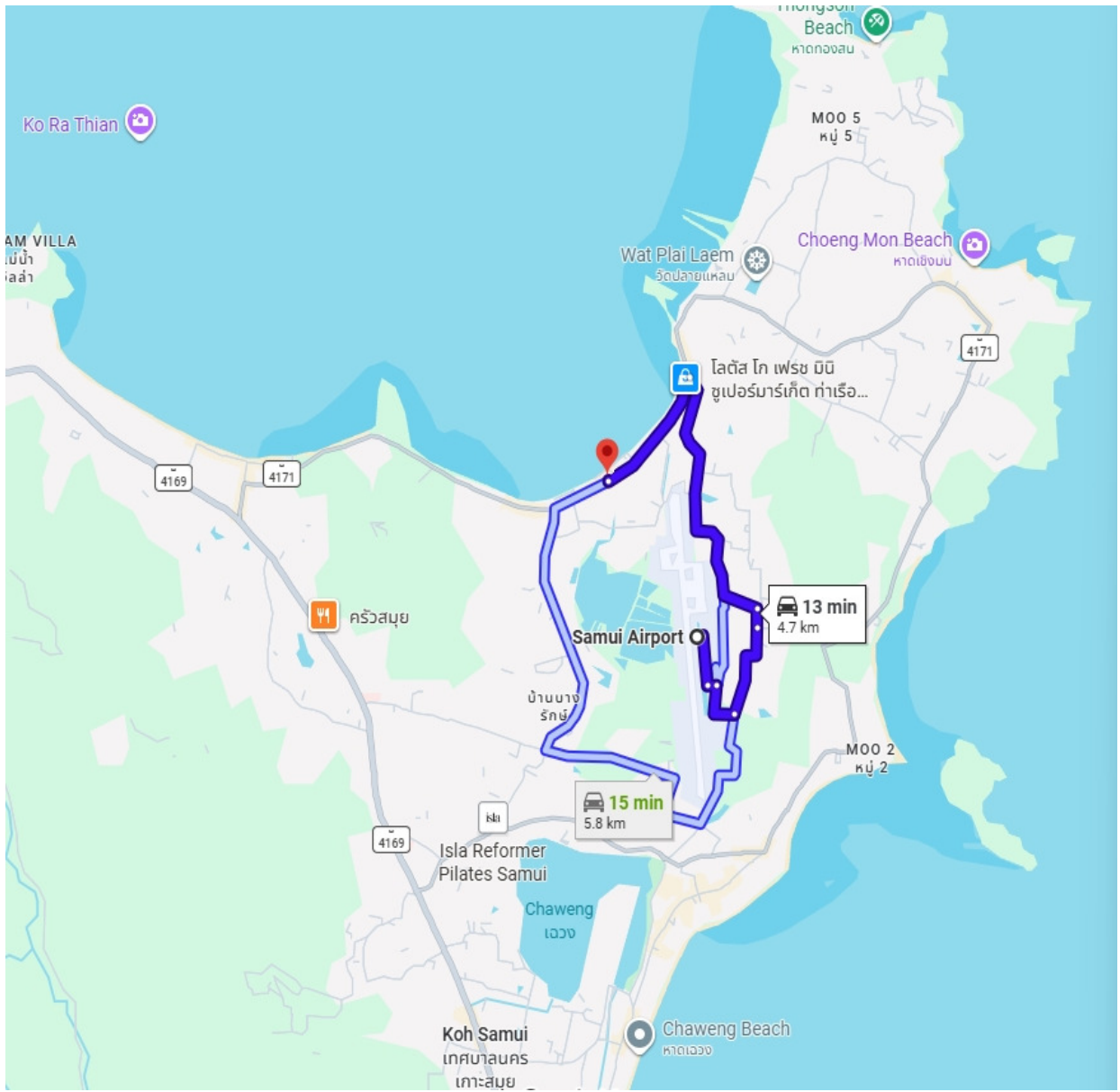

ENVIRONMENT

SAILING CONDITIONS

SAILING AREA

The period between April and August is considered the **main yacht charter season in Koh Samui**. This is because the Ko Samui area has an **inverted monsoon climate compared to Phuket**.¹

While the general Thailand sailing advice suggests the monsoon season runs from May through early October with hot, humid weather and heavy rains for the Phuket side, the climate is different in Ko Samui.²³⁴

Sailing in the Ko Samui area is described as a "real adventure under sail," with fewer boats than in Phuket, and it offers an experience in a protected wilderness that is quiet in the evening after day boats leave.

WEATHER

Between April and August, Ko Samui experiences a transition from the peak dry season to the tropical shoulder season.

- **April:** This is the **hottest month** of the year with the most daily sunshine (average 8 hours). Conditions are generally dry and festive, though humidity is high.
- **May - August:** These months represent a "shoulder" season. While the rest of Thailand (like Phuket) faces heavy southwest monsoon rains, Ko Samui remains **relatively dry and sunny**, making it a popular alternative for summer travel.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Samui: The Hot Season (March – August)

Alcohol

Alcohol can be bought locally at self-purchase, no token system in Samui trip by the cabin.

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewelry, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
