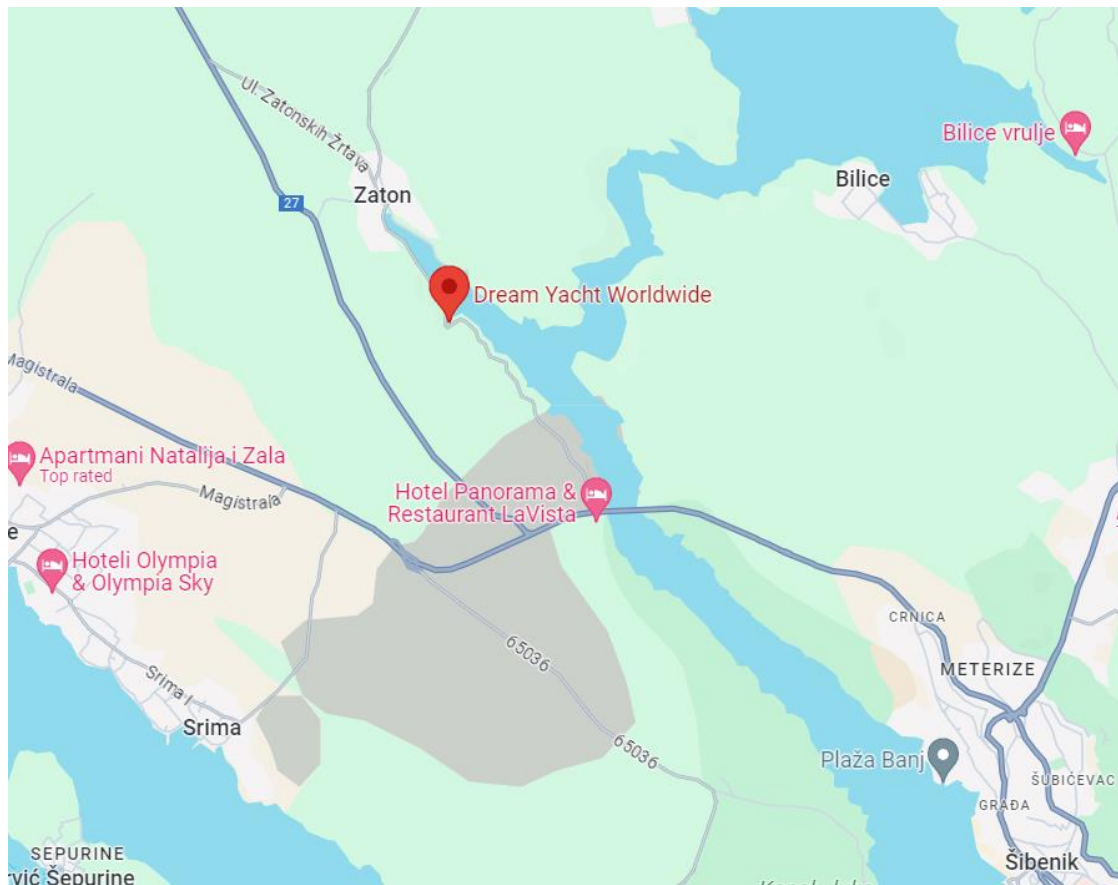

### INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine
- Service of the crew (skipper, hostess/cook)
- Half board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Zaton, Croatia: breakfast, lunch or dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),  
Towels: 1 set of towels / pax / charter (1 set = 1 face towel / 1 bath towel / 1 beach towel)
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)

## HOW TO GET THERE?

---

### ACCESS BY PLANE

Split Airport (SPU): The airport is 60km from the base, which is a 60-minute journey by car/shuttle. There are regular flights from Zagreb, Rim, Munich and Frankfurt with Croatia Airlines. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#). Zadar airport (ZAD) is 80k, from the base, a 60-minute journey.

### TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

### ACCESS BY ROAD

From direction Zagreb (north): Motorway A1 towards Split, exit Pirovac, after 1km turn left onto road 59 towards Skradin, after 3km turn right onto road 6072, after 8km turn left onto road 27 and after approx. 1,5km turn left onto road 6088 towards Zaton, arrive on destination on right after approx. 1km.

From direction Split (south): Motorway A1 towards Zagreb, exit Sibenik, follow directions to Sibenik after approx. 10km turn onto main coastal road D8 direction Zadar, after 5km turn right onto road 6088 towards Zaton, arrive on destination on right after approx. 1km.

## **AREA GUIDE**

---

### **LOCAL AREA INTRODUCTION**

Centrally located on the Krka River between Zadar and Split, the picturesque old city of Šibenik (pronounced 'see-be-nik') is an ideal point to start and end your yacht charter on the Dalmatian coast.

Known as one of the best-preserved authentic mediaeval towns in the entire region, Šibenik is also home to St. James's cathedral, a UNESCO world heritage site.

Guests get to explore a wide variety of harbors, marinas and anchorages on a Šibenik yacht charter, or spend several days in a variety of historic locations immersing themselves in the history of the region.

To sail from our base in Šibenik, you will need a sailing license that is recognized by the local port authorities, or you can hire a skipper. Read our guide to sailing qualifications for more information.

### **TOP THINGS TO DO IN ŠIBENIK:**

1. Sightsee as you sail to the peaceful island of Zlarin: Sail out from the marina to the Bay of Šibenik where you will pass by the 16th century St Nicholas Fortress enroute to Zlarin.

2. Learn about grape and olive production on Kaprije: Kaprije is home to about 100 inhabitants who use the island to grow olives and grapes. There are no cars there and it was also where the movie Mediterraneo was filmed.
3. Explore the Kornati Islands National Park: One of our favorite things to do in Šibenik, is sailing to the Kornati Islands National Park. The park is made up of nearly 100 islands and many are uninhabited. You will need to purchase a special permit to sail in the park.
4. Sail into Krka National Park: Visiting Krka National Park needs to be on your itinerary. Swim in the crystal clear water of the park and be sure to check out the park's seven waterfalls.
5. Sightsee in Šibenik Old City: If you're renting a boat in Šibenik, walk from the marina and explore the old city's architecture and UNESCO world heritage sites, including the St. James's cathedral and Town Hall.

## WEATHER

The best time to visit Šibenik is between May and October, as you'll enjoy a sunny, hot and dry climate. Be aware that the hottest and most crowded months to visit are July and August, so you may want to visit outside of these months.

The average temperature in Šibenik in summer is usually between 78°F (26°C) and 95°F (35°C). The sea temperature in Šibenik is between 75°F (24°C) and 82°F (27°C) during the summer months.

## TEMPERATURE

Climate in Šibenik, Croatia:

- Summer high: The July high is around 90°F (32°C)
- Winter low: The January low is 35°F (1°C)

## WHAT TO PACK

---

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors



- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewellery, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
