HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Martinique Aimé Césaire International Airport (FDF): The airport is 43km from the base, which is a 45-minute journey by car/shuttle. Regular flights are available from most major cities. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need an organized transfer from the airport, please contact please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

Leave the airport and get on the N5. Continue to Le Marin - Marina Le Marin - Bassin Tortue - Boulevard Allègre to our Le Marin base.

YOUR CRUISE

We often propose excursion packages on cabin cruise, don't hesitate to speak to your sales advisor to book them in advance or directly at the office.

- **DRINK TOKENS** In addition to the included beverages (1 local cocktail every evening per 1/2L table wine per day per guest during meals, fruit juices, sodas) additional alcoholic drinks such as beer, cocktails (same as the included ones), or full bottles of wine can be redeemed on board using tokens (not by the glass). Tokens cost €4 each and can be purchased only on the spot at check-in (not on board). Unused tokens are refundable or can be exchanged at the base – subject to availability – for goodies like T-shirts or caps.
- It is essential for each passenger to have a passport valid for a minimum of six months beyond the return date. A copy of your passports should be sent at least 2 weeks before your departure to the organizer of your cruise. Without copies of passports, we are unable to complete customs formalities and guests will not be able to board. Some nationalities need a visa for St Lucia and it is your responsibility to make the request if necessary.

CURRENCY: The currency in Martinique is the Euro. On the English-speaking islands (further south: Sainte Lucie, St Vincent, etc.), the local currency is the Caribbean Dollar (EC \$). Withdrawal of Caribbean Dollars possible in Bequia (1st stop). US Dollars and Euros are not always accepted.

INTERNET

The Wi-Fi in Martinique is free at our marina. Getting online is easy with plenty of Wi-Fi spots in restaurants and cafes, but you may find that speeds vary. No Wi-Fi onboard.

ENVIRONMENT

- Respect your surroundings and leave only footprints in the sand
- Respect regulations around marine reserves and private islands

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided).
- Most of the time you will be barefoot onboard, so take just one pair to go ashore and water shoes for the reef.
