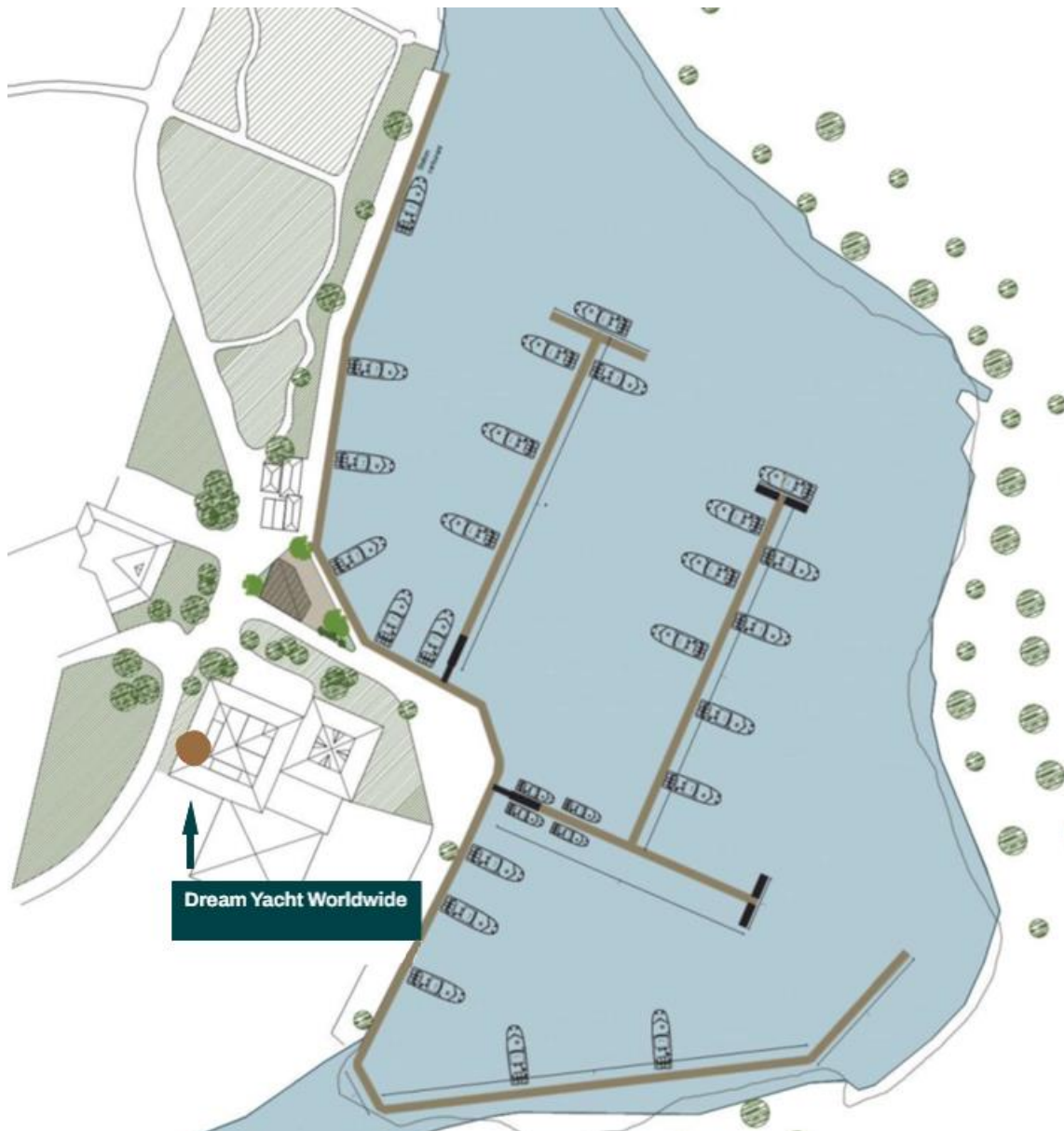

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Princess Juliana International Airport (SXM): There are regular flights from various US cities and direct flights from Paris. The taxi transfer to our marina takes 30 minutes.

Grand-Case Esperance Airport (SFG) is on the French side of the island and is used mainly for regional flights from nearby Caribbean islands.

Register a New Sint Maarten Entry Form

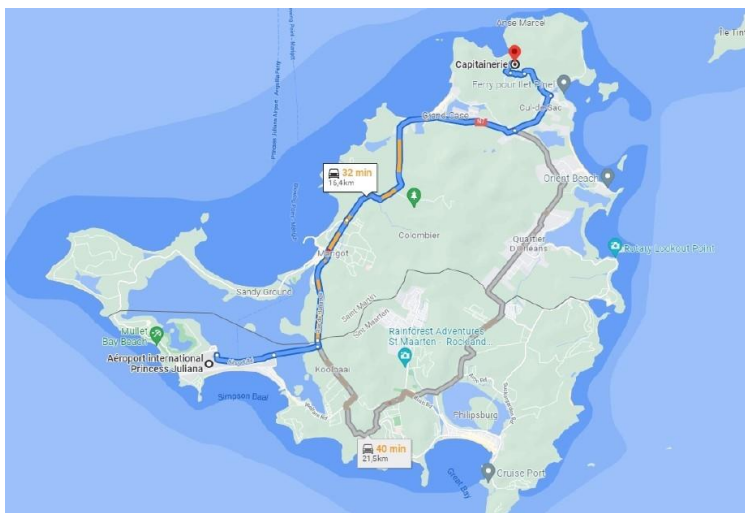
Complete your official entry form prior to arrival in Sin Maarten. This digital entry form is the official Embarkation Disembarkation (ED) Card for travelling to (Dutch) Sint Maarten. All travellers residing, transferring through or visiting Sin Maarten and St. Martin (French side) are required to fill out this form.

USEFUL INFORMATION

CURRENCY: The currency in St. Martin is the Euro (EUR), but US Dollars (USD) are also accepted on both sides of the island.

VOLTAGE: 220 V & 110 V (depending on which part of the island you are visiting)

DIALING CODE: +590

INTERNET

There are Wi-Fi spots in many bars and restaurants throughout the cruising ground. Cell phones can work depending on zones but don't forget the roaming fees!

You can also buy a SIM card & data at Digicel (located at Hope Estate or Marigot).

ENVIRONMENT

- Respect your surroundings and leave only footprints in the sand
- Respect regulations around marine reserves and private islands

WEATHER CONDITIONS

The best time to visit Saint-Martin is during the dry season, between January and June. The climate in the region is intertropical, with temperatures around 28°C all year round.

There is only a slight variation between the dry season (January to June) and the wet season (June to December). There is no real rainy season like on neighbouring islands, but you may experience light rain during the day.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Saint Martin :

- Summer : The maximum in August is around 31°C
- Winter : In December, minimum values are around 20°C

YOUR CRUISE

- It is essential that each passenger must have a passport valid for 6 months after the return date. A copy of your passports should be sent before your departure to the organizer of your cruise.
- **DRINK TOKENS** - In addition to the included beverages (1 local cocktail every evening per 1/2L table wine per day per guest during meals, fruit juices, sodas) additional alcoholic drinks such as

beer, cocktails (same as the included ones), or full bottles of wine can be redeemed on board using tokens (not by the glass). Tokens cost €4 each and can be purchased only on the spot at check-in (not on board). Unused tokens are refundable or can be exchanged at the base – subject to availability – for goodies like T-shirts or caps.

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
