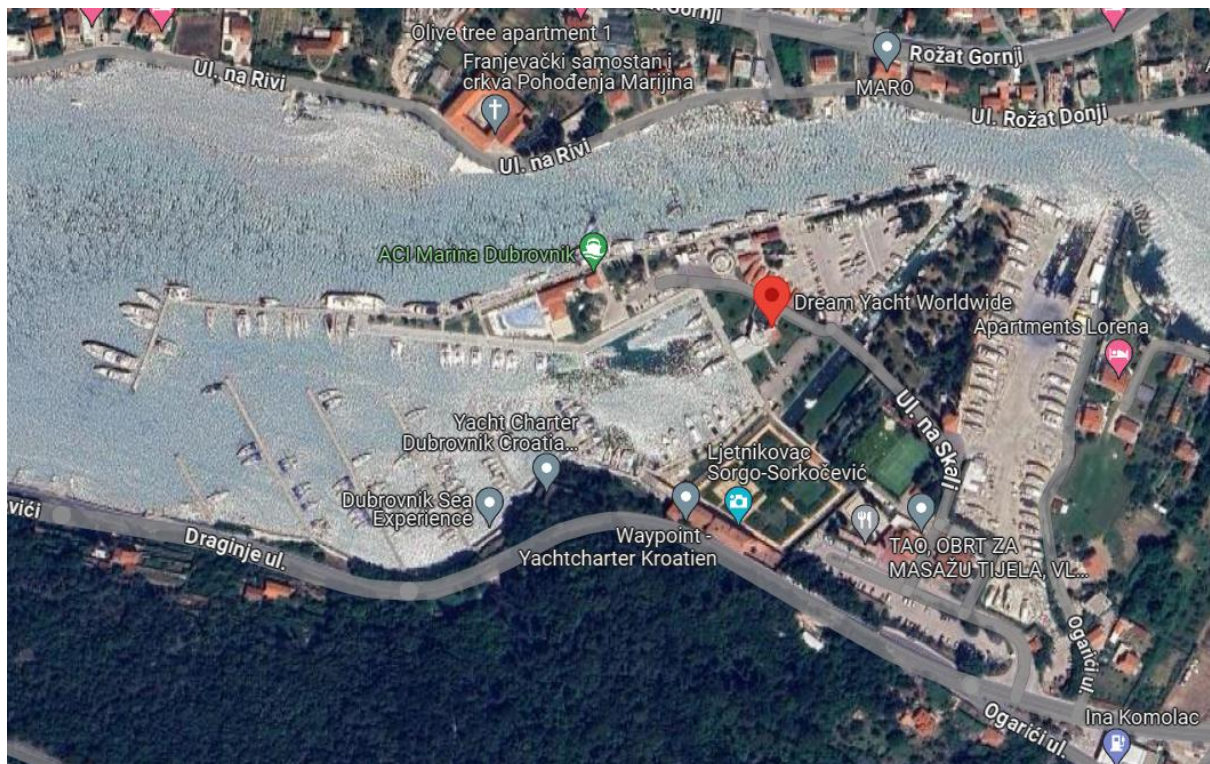

INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The rates include:

- First & last night at the Dream Yacht base
- The boat and its equipment, dinghy, and outboard engine
- Service of the crew (skipper, hostess/cook)
- Half board is standard on Easy Crewed Charters in Dubrovnik, Croatia: breakfast, lunch or dinner including soft drinks
- Linen: 1 set of linen / cabin / charter (1 set = 2 sheets / 2 pillow cases / 1 blanket),
Towels: 1 set of towels / pax / charter (1 set = 1 face towel / 1 bath towel / 1 beach towel)
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)
- Water sports on board: snorkeling gear & 1 paddleboard
- End cleaning
- Harbour and mooring fees
- On catamarans 54 ft and larger: shower gel & shampoo plus a 2nd paddleboard

The rates do not include:

- Cruising and tourist taxes, clearance and custom fees, island fees if there are any
- Cancellation insurance and private insurance
- Alcoholic drinks (possible to order separately) and special meal requests
- Personal expenses and excursions
- Crew gratuity
- And more generally that is not explicitly stated

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Dubrovnik Airport (DBV): The airport is 23km from the base, which is a 30-minute journey by car/shuttle. There are regular flights from Zagreb with Croatia Airlines. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

Via Zagreb: Use the highway to travel from Zagreb to Dubrovnik. Drive from Zagreb to Split on the A1 Zagreb-Split highway. Continue for 3.5 hours, depending on the traffic, from Split to Dubrovnik on the "Adriatic Magistral" road. If you chose to take the old sight-seeing road from Zagreb to Dubrovnik, it'll take you 9.5 hours. To avoid Split, turn left after Sinj, towards Trilj, and then turn right towards Cist Provo. Turn right towards Šestanovac and exit on the "Adriatic Magistral" road, just after Gornja Brela, which will take you to Dubrovnik. After passing the bridge, turn left at the first crossing. Travel straight ahead until you are in Komolac. The first road on the left is the entrance to the ACI Marina Dubrovnik.

ACCESS BY BUS

One of the cheapest ways to get to Dubrovnik is by bus. Croatia has a well-developed national transport network of bus routes that reach even the smallest villages on the coast. Bus routes connect Dubrovnik with Croatia's major cities and run several times a day. Regular international bus routes connect Croatia with Austria, Italy, Hungary, France, Germany, Slovakia, Bosnia-Herzegovina and many others. You can easily travel from Dubrovnik to ACI Marina by bus 1A or 1B and get off at Komolac (just after the INA petrol pump).

BAGGAGE

Please only take soft bags and not suitcases, as they would be too cumbersome onboard.

PARKING

At the ACI Marina in Dubrovnik, there are two parking areas. The initial parking lot has a daily rate of 25 EUR, with a weekly cost of 80 EUR. For the parking lot nearer to the pontoons, the daily fee is 55 EUR, and the weekly rate is 160 EUR.

AREA GUIDE

LOCAL AREA INTRODUCTION

The UNESCO ancient walled city of Dubrovnik is so much more than the famed set of the hit television series, Game of Thrones. Dubrovnik has a Mediterranean climate, fantastic sailing conditions, a long sailing season and short leg passages, which means plenty of opportunities to enjoy the region.

You can explore the attractive Elaphiti Islands archipelago with a Dubrovnik yacht charter, which will entertain even the most experienced sailors and travelers. From our base in ACI Marina Dubrovnik, Komolac, you can immerse yourself in the multi-cultural region and sail the startling blue-green Adriatic.

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TOP THINGS TO DO IN DUBROVNIK:

1. Enjoy Dubrovnik Summer Festival: If you sail Dubrovnik in summer, try to coincide with this popular event held in July and August. The program includes exciting dance performances, live music and cinema screenings
2. Swim at Šunj Beach: Sail Lopud and explore this beautiful beach in the south or head around to the northern coast of the island for excellent restaurants and a walk around the botanical garden.
3. Visit Šipanska Luka: Your Dubrovnik itinerary needs to include Šipan, the biggest Elaphiti Island, and moor in this port. Explore the island's many churches, palace or pine forests and you might want to try the local wine too, as it's known for its vineyards.
4. Explore Mljet National Park: If you're sailing Mljet, moor at a local restaurant in Polače for lunch with a view. Explore the nearby park, visit the Salt Lakes or head further along the coast to the Mistral Tavern at Okuklje for dinner. Prožura is worth stopping at for a swim.
5. Walk Korčula Old City: If you're renting a boat in Korčula, make a reservation at the ACI Korčula marina and explore the city, the supposed birthplace of Marco Polo. Enjoy St Mark's Cathedral with its amazing views and Revelin Tower, or head south to Pupnatska Luka Beach.
6. Anchor at Jakljan: For an uninhabited island experience, enjoy the silence at Jakljan. This island is undeveloped but is one of the best swimming spots for a Dubrovnik yacht charter.

WEATHER

The best time to visit Dubrovnik is between May and October when the climate is Mediterranean, with hot and dry days.

The average temperature in Dubrovnik in summer is between 78°F (26°C) and 95°F (36°C) with nearly 3,000 sunny hours a year. The sea temperature in Dubrovnik in summer is between 75°F (24°C) and 82°F (27°C).

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Dubrovnik, Croatia:

- Summer high: The July high is around 84°F (29°C)
- Winter low: The January/February low is 43°F (6°C)

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewelry, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
