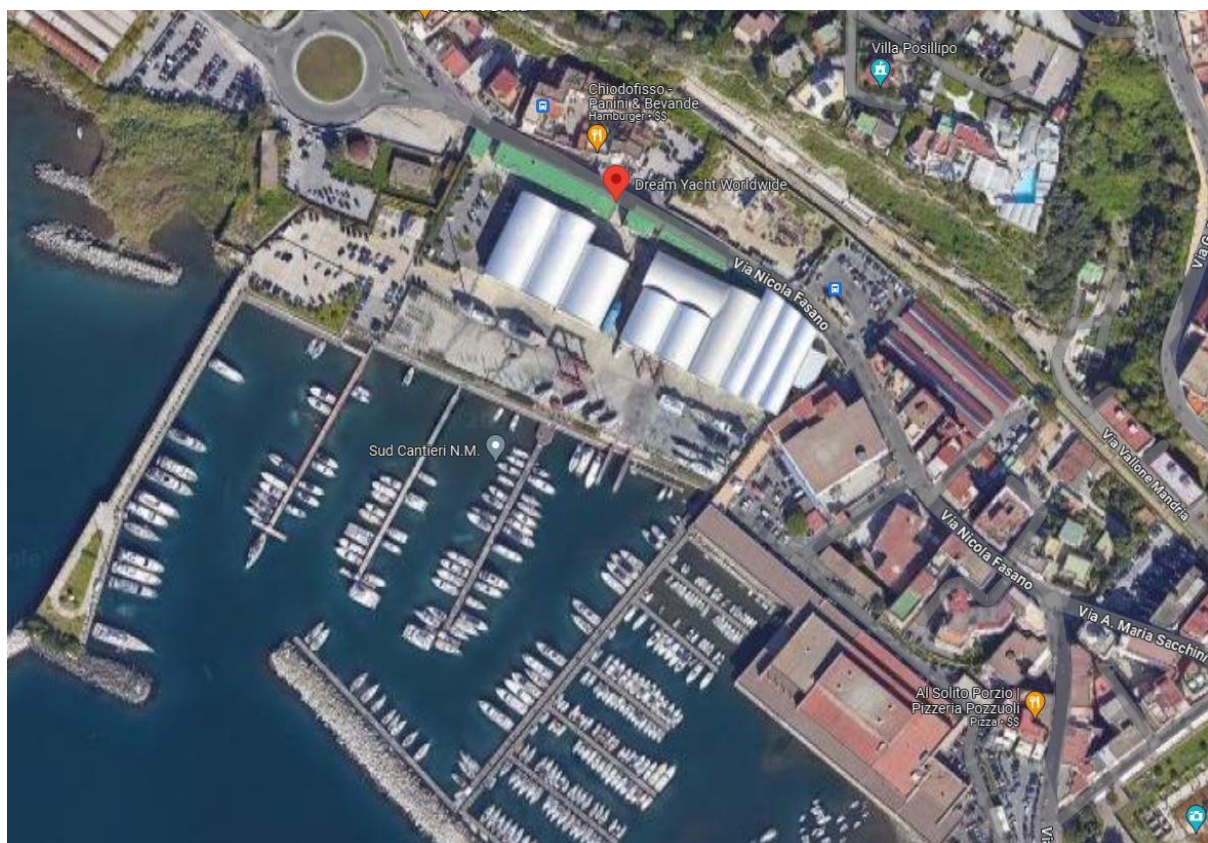
OPENING HOURS: 8am – 6pm

**** Effective June 1, 2024, the municipality of Pozzuoli has implemented a *tourist tax* for every person staying overnight within the municipality, including those staying on board vessels. This tax **must be paid directly to the marina**, which will then forward the payment to the municipality and provide a receipt to the clients.**

Additionally, ALL passport COPIES - not just the crew list - must be uploaded to Nausys at least 10 days prior to charter start date - Otherwise boarding will not be permitted and local municipality office may open again after 1 or 2 days

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Naples International Airport: (NAP): The airport is 23km from the base, which is a 30-minute journey by car/shuttle. Direct flights from New York with United Airlines or via London, Turkey or Ireland. Please check the schedule on the [airport website](#).

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

If you are driving to Naples follow the signs for Tangenziale, the Naples bypass (autostrada A56) and then exit in Pozzuoli via Campana. At the first crossroad after the exit, turn right following the road signs for Marina Sud Cantieri which is about 1km away.

ACCESS BY ROAD

You can reach the base by bus from Naples. Take bus number R7 to the bus station close to the marina.

ACCESS BY METRO

You can reach the center of Pozzuoli from Naples' historical center using the **Cumana railway**, commonly referred to as **Line 4**. This commuter rail line connects **Montesanto Station** in Naples to **Torregaveta**, passing through Pozzuoli.

Travel Details:

- Departure Point: Montesanto Station is located in Naples' historical center.
- Arrival Point: Pozzuoli Station, situated in the center of Pozzuoli.
- Journey Time: Approximately 30 minutes.
- Frequency: Trains run approximately every 20 minutes

Please only take soft bags and not suitcases, as they would be too cumbersome onboard.

WEATHER

The best time to for Naples sailing charters is between spring and fall. The summer months are the warmest and also the most popular time to visit. Naples has a long sailing season and you might want to consider the low season and enjoy the warmer weather and fewer crowds.

The temperature in Naples in summer averages 91°F (33°C) with sea temperatures in summer as warm as 77° F (25°C).

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Naples:

- Summer high: The July high is around 86°F (30°C)
- Winter low: The January low is 41°F (5°C)

YOUR CRUISE

DRINK TOKENS In addition to the included beverages (1 local cocktail every evening per 1/2L table wine per day per guest during meals, fruit juices, sodas) additional alcoholic drinks such as beer, cocktails (same as the included ones), or full bottles of wine can be redeemed on board using tokens (not by the glass). Tokens cost €4 each and can be purchased only on the spot at check-in (not on board). Unused tokens are refundable or can be exchanged at the base – subject to availability – for goodies like T-shirts or caps.

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up - hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)
- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewellery, make-up and hair straighteners behind – it's time to relax!
