

EMBARKATION TIME

The average embarkation time is 4pm, or we will assign you a designated time in the afternoon/evening for you to begin your check in procedure, according to the availability of your catamaran/monohull.

YACHT BRIEFING



At your scheduled boarding time, the yacht will be ready for your inspection prior to loading any gear on board. A full technical explanation of all systems and functions will be given, along with a review of navigation, paper charts and answers to any additional questions.

STOP OVERS

You may spend the first night of your check-in date on a mooring (please mention preference in advance of boarding) at no additional charge. Subsequent nights on a mooring are an additional cost and based on availability.

DISEMBARKATION TIME

Call us at 8.30 am the morning of your departure to notify of your arrival in the morning. Average check out time is approximately 30 - 60 minutes.

CAR PARKING

The parking at the marina is complimentary for those holding the Parking Pass that will be assigned to you by the Base Manager. As long as you have that pass hanging in your vehicle, your vehicle can be parked in the marina parking lot. The Parking Pass needs to be given back to the Base Manager at check out.

BAGGAGE

Please only take soft bags and not suitcases, as they would be too cumbersome onboard.

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Rhode Island T.F. Green International Airport:

The airport is 7 km from the base, which is a 15 minutes journey by car/shuttle ride. There are regular flights from all domestic and international cities with all major airline carriers, please check the schedule at the **airport's website**.

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact our base manager. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

ACCESS BY ROAD

From Boston:

Get on I-93 S from Sudbury St. Follow I-93 S and I-95 S to RI-113 E/East Ave in Warwick. Take exit 12A from I-95 S. Take Greenwich Ave and Post Rd to Folly Landing Rd

From New York City:

Get on FDR Dr from Spruce St and Frankfort St. Follow I-95 N to RI-117 E/Centerville Rd in Warwick. Take exit 10 from I-95 N. Continue on Centerville Rd. Take Post Rd to Folly Landing Rd.

Located close to Newport - the home to the most famous sailing race in the world – America's Cup, it offers a glimpse offers a glimpse into the sailing history of the United States, from its charming downtown, which boasts the homes of many seafaring captains. You'll get to explore all of this history on our Warwick charter boats vacation.

While many sailing destinations hold themselves as the best in the world, Newport really is the center of the sailing community with over 400 miles of US shoreline and a rich, maritime heritage. Its calm breezes mean it is popular with sailors.

The region's ports allow you to experience a fascinating history, as well as some of the most notable tourist destinations in the US. Your itinerary possibilities are endless and can include Martha's Vineyard, Nantucket and Cape Cod. All are peaceful escapes offering something for everyone.



TOP THINGS TO DO IN RHODE ISLAND:

- 1. Historical Sites: Founded in 1642, Warwick has plenty of places to transport you back to simpler times.
- 2. Parks and Beaches: It's no secret, Lil Rhody is home to the most storied beachfront property in the United States, and when you have it, you flaunt it. As one of the peninsulas in the Narragansett Bay, Warwick has plenty of beaches to talk about. SAILING CONDITIONS

SAILING AREA

Sail to Martha's Vineyard during your Warwick yacht rental, which is the summer playground of the rich and famous, as well as the filming location for Jaws. Head to the Hamptons on Long Island with its charming towns and villages, gourmet restaurants, lively bars and upscale boutiques.

If you would like to get back to nature, you can spend your day whale watching, fishing, hiking or picnicking in Wetherill State Park, located at the southeastern tip of Conanicut Island. If you want the bustle of the city, nearby Boston offers sites that helped shape American politics.

Dutch Harbor is a lovely spot in the West Passage between Dutch Island and Conanicut Island, giving access to Jamestown less than a mile away. Enjoy the view of the harbour.

Wickford is a wonderful harbour and typical Rhode Island fishing village. Prudence Island is right in the middle of Narragansett bay between Portsmouth and Bristol. Bristol Harbour is not far from Prudence Island and you can visit Herreshoff Maritime Museum.

Head up Fall River to Battleship Cove and tie up alongside a submarine – an amazing destination if you are on a family sail with children

WEATHER

Summer is obviously a great time to be in Warwick for a sailing vacation. The weather is great, with average high temperatures of 80 degrees most days, and average lows of about 60°F in the evening. On average, there are over 200 sunny days each year in Newport.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Warwick, Rhode Island:

- Summer High: The July high is around 80 degrees
- Winter Low: The January low is 23 degrees

WIND SYSTEMS

From April to October, experience calmer winds perfect for any sailing vacation. The best wind of the year comes in July, reaching up to 6 miles per hour.
